CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSELL D. AND CHRIS HUDSON  
3570 GALLS CREEK ROAD

confirms the right to use the waters of BEAR GULCH SPRING, a tributary of GALLS CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41133. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 29, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 4, T 37 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 670 FEET SOUTH AND 370 FEET EAST FROM C 1/4 CORNER SECTION 4.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 4  
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
