confirms the right to store the waters of FORT CREEK
a tributary of SOUTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK
AND WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir
permit R-9856. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1983.

The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right
is not more than 0.07 ACRE-FOOT.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE1/4 NW1/4
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and
maintenance of an outlet pipe or the provision of other means to
evacuate the stored water when determined necessary by the Water
Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
