CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That GEORGE P. LEE of Paulina State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Moppin Spring, tributary to Crooked River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of seven acres of land, and stock and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1909,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock and domestic use, and 9/100 cubic foot per second from July 1st to September 15th of each year for irrigation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Three acres in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4; four acres in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4; Section Two (2), Township Seventeen (17) South Range Twenty-three (23) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

Note: The limited irrigation season set forth herein is in error and should conform to the season as defined in the Decree. See document filed adjacent to Certificate etc.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
