confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED DRAW, a tributary of THREEMILE CREEK, in RESERVOIRS 1 AND 2, appropriated under Permit 29550, for the purpose of IRRIGATION, STOCK AND FISH CULTURE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-3958. The date of priority is APRIL 7, 1964. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 15.0 ACRE-FEET, BEING 5.5 AF IN RESERVOIR 1 FOR FISH CULTURE AND STOCK AND 9.5 AF IN RESERVOIR 2 FOR IRRIGATION AND STOCK.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
