CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.J. CODY

confirms the right to use the waters of RESERVOIR 2, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-3958, a tributary of THREEMILE CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 28.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 29550. The date of priority is APRIL 7, 1964. The right is limited to not more than 9.5 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 4 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 120 FEET SOUTH AND 1290 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, AND SHALL BE FURTHER LIMITED TO A TOTAL DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 9.5 ACRE FEET PER YEAR.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 28.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
