Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880 for Tract #1; 1884 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said decree):

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1:

Seven (7) acres in the rest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWANEA), Four (4) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NEANWA), Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twelve (12) South, Range Forty (40) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 11 acres.

Tract #2:

Fifteen (15) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NEANEA), Seven (7) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NVANEA), Four (4) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NEANWA), Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Twelve (12) South, Range Forty (40) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 26 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
