CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.45 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 7448. The date of priority is JULY 17, 1926. The right is limited to not more than 0.188 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 1 S, R 3 W,
W.M.; 925 FEET NORTH & 2040 FEET WEST FROM S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.15 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 5.30 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the right originally evidenced by certificate 8881, State record of Water Right Certificates, as modified by the Decree of the Circuit Court for Washington County on February 11, 1939, and also to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION authorized by an order of the State Engineer entered on October 31, 1950, approving transfer H-79, and also to describe that portion of the right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 21, 1988 approving transfer T-6065.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
