confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE SHEEP CREEK, a tributary of IMNAHA RIVER, for the purpose of FISH REARING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49962. The date of priority is JUNE 4, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 19.6 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 1 S, R 47 E, W.M.; 68 FEET NORTH AND 670 FEET WEST FROM SOUTHEAST CORNER NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
