CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN ALBERT CHANDLER

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of EAGLE CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND DAIRY BARN USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42264. The date of priority is JULY 15, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.015 CFS FOR DAIRY BARN, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 9 S, R 45 E, W.M.; 2190 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 15.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
