## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR FOUR FAMILIES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42070. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42, SECTION 19, T 22 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 1150 FEET SOUTH AND 1440 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 19.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
