confirms the right to use the waters of LEE CREEK, a tributary of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42741. The date of priority is AUGUST 30, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 28 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 390 FEET SOUTH AND 730 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 28.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
