CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of THOMAS CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.3 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42634. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 29, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversions are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48, SECTION 10, T 10 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 200 FEET WEST; 850 FEET SOUTH, BOTH FROM NE CORNER DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.2 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
