CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of STAG HOLLOW CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND STOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45735. The date of priority is OCTOBER 1, 1979, FOR 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND NOVEMBER 10, 1980, FOR 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48, SECTION 11,
T 3 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 610 FEET SOUTH AND 760 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER
SECTION 11.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 DOMESTIC
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 2

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 STOCK
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
