CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDVIEW SPRING, a tributary of MT. EMILY CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE AT GRANDVIEW CAMPGROUND.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48500. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 1.0 GALLON PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 1 S, R 38 E, W.M.; 1980 FEET SOUTH AND 515 FEET EAST FROM NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 29.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
