CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45797. The date of priority is MAY 18, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 12 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 1290 FEET SOUTH AND 640 FEET EAST FROM THE C1/4 CORNER SECTION 34.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 34  
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
