confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 252. The date of priority is 1902.

The right is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT OF WATER PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 39 S, R 7 W, W.M.; WHITE-CHAPMAN DITCH.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES  
SECTION 30  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 18, 1983, and together with certificate 52059, supersedes certificate 7130, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
