confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of WATER FOR STOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47374. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 13 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 500 FEET SOUTH AND 1860 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 24.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
