confirms the right to use the waters of NOYER CREEK AND LAKE MICHIGAN RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8465, a tributary of DEEP CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46848. The date of priority is JANUARY 13, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 2 S, R 3 E, W.M.; 630 FEET SOUTH AND 1660 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 11.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 11  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
