confirms the right to store the waters of AN INTERMITTENT STREAM, a tributary of CALLOWAY CREEK, in ADAIR POND, appropriated under Permit 49026, for the purpose of WARM WATER FISH REARING AND WATERFOWL REFUGE.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10061. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 7, 1984. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 43.0 ACRE-FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

THE DAM IS TO BE OPERATED AND MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE TO THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
