confirms the right to use the waters of AN INTERMITTENT STREAM AND ADAIR POND CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10061, tributaries of CALLOWAY CREEK, for the purpose of WARM WATER FISH REARING AND WATERFOWL REFUGE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49026. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 7, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58, SECTION 30, T 10 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1760 FEET NORTH AND 2000 FEET WEST FROM NORTHEAST CORNER DLC 57.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
