CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DORIS AND FRANK TOSCHE
ROUTE 1, BOX 220 T
FOREST GROVE, OREGON 97116

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED CREEK, a tributary of GALES CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/4 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18630. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1949. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 1 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 650 FEET SOUTH AND 650 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 3, 1977, and together with certificate 45123, supersedes certificate 21468, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
