CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CLEAR CREEK, a tributary of DEER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 5.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42736. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 8, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.115 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.11 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 940 FEET SOUTH AND 1470 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.0 ACRE

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.1 ACRES AND DOMESTIC

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.2 ACRES

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.2 ACRE

SECTION 11

TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
