CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CRYSTAL GIENGER
MONUMENT, OREGON 97864

confirms the right to use the waters of COTTONWOOD CREEK, a tributary of NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43455. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 10 S, R 27 E, W.M.; 120 FEET SOUTH AND 2450 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 ACRE
SECTION 24

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.6 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.6 ACRE
SECTION 25

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
