CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of ROSS SLOUGH, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47597. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 26 S, R 13 W, W.M.; 380 FEET SOUTH AND 545 FEET EAST FROM N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 24.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
