THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of EAST FORK COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of PARK USE IN FRONA COUNTY PARK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48510. The date of priority is OCTOBER 13, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 28 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 3820 FEET NORTH AND 2540 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 11.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 11  
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
