CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE MILE CREEK, a tributary of WHITE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.4 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at page 196. The date of priority is 1898.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 4 S, R 11 E, W.M.;
ROUND PRAIRIE DITCH - 1530 FEET SOUTH & 4580 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH 24 AND ALL OTHER CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN SAID DECREE.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 8.4 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 26, 1979, and supersedes certificate 5773, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
