confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, a tributary of APPLGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 50.79 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1880.

The right is limited to not more than 0.84 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 39 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 580 FEET SOUTH & 670 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 40.00 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.79 ACRES  
SECTION 5  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 44001, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 25, 1986, approving transfer application 5838.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
