CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGIA-PACIFIC CORPORATION COQUILLE DIVISION P.O. BOX 610 COQUILLE, OREGON 97423

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 15.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 38636. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 17, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 28 S, R 11 W, W.M.; DIVERSION 1 - NORTH 62 DEGREES WEST, 600 FEET FROM SE CORNER, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26; DIVERSION 2 - NORTH 30 DEGREES EAST, 660 FEET FROM SW CORNER, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 8.0 ACRES SECTION 26

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 7.0 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
