The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1875.

The right is limited to not more than 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: LOWER WAKEMAN DITCH, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 34, R 4 W, W.M.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 34 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 440 FEET SOUTH & 530 FEET WEST; 900 FEET SOUTH & 560 FEET WEST BOTH FROM NE CORNER SECTION 33.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 3.9 ACRES SECTION 34

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.2 ACRES SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 12, 1977, and supersedes certificate 44082, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
