CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CAROLINE E. ROGERS
ECHO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTER CREEK, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 202.5 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 250. The date of priority is 1869 FOR 2 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND AND 1880 FOR 1.40 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

The right is limited to not more than 3.40 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2683, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on OCTOBER 17, 1988.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
