CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM G. REID 350 MONA WAY CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of TYCER CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8267, a tributary of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.95 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45725. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.061 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 39 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 950 FEET SOUTH AND 2050 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year FROM DIRECT FLOW AND STORAGE FROM RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8267.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 4.95 ACRES SECTION 19 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
