CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of FOSTER CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of POTABLE WATER AT FOSTER BAR BOAT RAMP.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49265. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 34 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 180 FEET NORTH AND 120 FEET EAST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
