confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER, for the purpose of FISH REARING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49961. The date of priority is JUNE 4, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 13.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 2 N, R 41 E, W.M.; 37 FEET NORTH AND 2075 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 28.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 41 EAST, W.M.

he right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
