CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLIFTON CLEAVER  
PRAIRIE CITY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 140.76 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 2887. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1916. The right is limited to not more than 1.77 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 13 S, R 34 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4	40.00 ACRES	NE 1/4 SW 1/4	11.00 ACRES

SECTION 11  
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2854, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on JANUARY 26, 1989.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
