## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

P.F. HOLT 3291 LITTLE APPLEGATE ROAD JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO INFILTRATION TRENCHES in the LITTLE APPLEGATE RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 12.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-6921. The date of priority is JUNE 25, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The trenches are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; TRENCH 1 - 700 FEET NORTH AND 10 FEET WEST; TRENCH 2 - 600 FEET NORTH AND 20 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT IT DOES NOT IMPAIR OR SUBSTAINTIALLY INTERFERE WITH THE EXISTING SURFACE WATER RIGHTS OF OTHERS.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 12.0 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
