CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That LEWIS MCCALLISTER of Howard State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Ochoco Creek, a tributary of Crooked River

for the purpose of the storage of one thousand acre feet, the development of forty-five theoretical horsepower, and mining, also domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1886,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and a continuous flow of five cubic feet per second for other purposes.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

The reservoir is located in Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirteen (13), South Range Twenty (20) East of Willamette Meridian. Mining claims are located in Sections Nineteen (19), Twenty (21), Twenty-nine (29), and Thirty (30), Township Thirteen (13) South Range Twenty (20) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
