The right has been perfected under Permit 36243. The date of priority is AUGUST 21, 1972. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 27 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 90 FEET WEST FROM N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 34.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
