CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH AND SOUTH DRAINAGE DITCHES AND A SUMP RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-10529, tributaries of WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION AND THE SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 53.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49461. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM SOUTH DRAINAGE DITCH WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM THE SOUTH DRAINAGE DITCH TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM THE NORTH DRAINAGE DITCH FOR MAINTAINING 0.5 ACRE-FOOT OF STORED WATER IN THE SUMP RESERVOIR FOR RECREATION AND 12.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY FROM THE SUMP RESERVOIR FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 1 N, R 4 W, W.M.;
NORTH DITCH 1 - 1150 FEET SOUTH AND 920 FEET EAST, SOUTH DITCH
2 - 1910 FEET SOUTH AND 860 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER,
SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	0.8 ACRE
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	25.2 ACRES AND RECREATION
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	22.8 ACRES AND RECREATION
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	4.6 ACRES

SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
