This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 31733, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on OCTOBER 17, 1988.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
