confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of ROSS SLOUGH, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR THREE FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44708. The date of priority is JUNE 13, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 26 S, R 13 W, W.M.; 230 FEET SOUTH AND 700 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 1.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

he right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
