CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JAMES A INSWORTH

of La Grande, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Grande Ronde River
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
 acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth
 of a cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Eight and one tenth (8.1) acres in the North-
 west Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 and Ten (10) acres in the Southwest Quarter of
 the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Four
(4), Township 3 South, Range 38 East of the
 Willamette Meridian, being a total of 18.1 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
