confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of ISTHMUS SLOUGH, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN AND ANIMAL SHELTER USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46198. The date of priority is JANUARY 25, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.005 CFS FOR ANIMAL SHELTER USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 26 S, R 13 W, W.M.; 730 FEET NORTH AND 770 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 22.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources
