confirms the right to store the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of GARRIGUS CREEK, in RESERVOIRS 1 AND 2, appropriated under Permit 48331, for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-9602. The date of priority is OCTOBER 12, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 26.0 ACRE-FEET, BEING 20.0 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR 1 AND 6.0 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR 2.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.	

The dam is to be operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications on file with the Water Resources Department.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
