CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILO AND JANET CAIN HC 60, BOX 600 LAKEVIEW, OREGON 97630

confirms the right to use of WASTE WATER, a tributary of GOOSE LAKE, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 11.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 27313. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1960. The right is limited to not more than 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, if available at the original point of diversion SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 6, T 41 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 50 FEET NORTH AND 1600 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 6.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 41 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 260 FEET SOUTH AND 940 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The appropriation shall be limited to the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water and is subject to the terms and conditions of an order entered at pages 90 to 93, volume 11, Special Order Record of the State Engineer, and by reference made a part hereof.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 30, 1981, and supersedes certificate 32560, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
