confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING a tributary of IMNAHA RIVER, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48940. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.0008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 1 S, R 48 E, W.M.; 1330 FEET NORTH AND 1325 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 22.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 22  
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 48 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
