CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE HANSEN
ROUTE 1, BOX 541
MT VERNON, OREGON 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.5 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44418. The date of priority is JUNE 4, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.04 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 20, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 1700 FEET NORTH AND 1700 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.9 ACRE AND LIVESTOCK
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.6 ACRE
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
