CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46637. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 5, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 540 FEET SOUTH AND 1660 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER SECTION 10.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39  
LOT 3 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
SECTION 4  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
