CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION

confirms the right to use the waters of SAIN CREEK, a tributary of SCOGGINS CREEK, for the purpose of OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A PUBLIC RECREATION AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 158. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 4, 1909. The right is limited to not more than 0.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 1 S, R 4 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 1 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 560 FEET SOUTH & 270 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 14.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SE 1/4 NW 1/4
NW 1/4 SW 1/4
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 55
LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 20, 1978 and supersedes certificate 726, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
