confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of ELK CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45483. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 18, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 13, T 22 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1100 FEET SOUTH AND 160 FEET EAST FROM N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 13.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4)
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the point of diversion and supersedes Certificate recorded at page 60512, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
