CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM C. MCGAHEY  
18508 WEST FORK EVANS CREEK ROAD  
ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK EVANS CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND THE IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 39438. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. The right is limited to not more than 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.04 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 34 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2050 FEET NORTH AND 150 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC  
SECTION 23

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE  
SECTION 24  
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
